



HOW TO PLAY?

OBJECTIVE

- Score as many runs as you can in six chances!
- Up to 4 people can play with one pack of Chai Cricket

SET UP

- There are 61 cards in one pack.
- Keep the 'Innings Declare' Card separately.
- Each player will receive 6 cards from the 60 cards.
- Rest of the cards will have to be placed in the middle.

GAME

- There will be a total of six turns alternatively each player.
- Accumulate as many runs as you can in the six chances.
- Drop a card with the playing side open for everyone to see & then pick one from the pack in the middle.

CHAI CRICKET INSIGHTS

- Always ensure each player has only six cards in hand (excluding Wide & No ball).
- You get an extra chance when you get wide or no ball.
- If you receive - Wide or No ball - as part of the first six cards, then show the card to all the players, keep it separately next to you and PICK another card from the middle.
- If you receive - Wide or No ball - when you pick a card from the middle, then show the card to all the players, keep it separately next to you and PICK another card from the middle.



WHAT IF YOU GET 'OUT'?

You are out! You can't drop the card.

INNINGS DECLARE

- You need to play at least one round out of the six to declare the innings.
- If you don't want to play any further after one round, you can pick the 'Innings Declare' card & declare.
- The game will go on till the rest of the players complete their quota of six turns.

NOTE

The only instance you can declare right at the start is when all six cards you have received are OUT!

WINNER

- The player with the most runs after six turns is the winner.
- In case of a tie, the player with the least number of wickets is the winner.
- In case the number of wickets are also equal, those players will play one more round to break the tie.
